Classroom Behaviors:

(Please note: This behavior is situational and may be different for every student)

Strategies:

- 1. Allow student to leave class when necessary
- 2. Allow student to have food or drink when necessary
- 3. Be aware that student may need to use insulin pump or needles during class
- 4. Discuss certain accommodations with student
 - a. Many students monitor their bloodsugar on their cell phone
 - b. Makes noise to alert student to changes in their bloodsugar
- 5. Make sure student is aware that they will not be penalized for these extra accommodations
- 6. Do not draw unnecessary attention to the student
