Term and Semester Hours

The Cooper Medical School of Rowan University operates under the semester system with two semesters (Fall and Spring) each academic year. The curriculum is a required course load described by the faculty with no substitutions. The Cooper Medical School of Rowan University does not assign credit hours to courses and does not calculate GPA.

Course Number System

A three character alphabetic Subject Code (MED) represents the department. This is followed by a 5 character alphanumeric group. In this group, the first three digits indicate the level of the course (015 for the first-year, 016 for the second-year, 017 for the third-year and 020 and up for the fourth-year).
