Specializations are variations of majors and are approved through a specific curriculum process in which they are identified aspecializations and designed to meet University and parameters. Specializations appear on student transcripts. Programs with specializations award one degree in one major, but may as multiple specializations designating specific credentials. cistications appear in GRAD and are generated there by Banner. Liberal Studies is a broad umbrella degree with multiple specializations, including Math/Science, Humanities/Social Science, and Literacy Studies. Specializations can be converted to full degree programs but must go through the new program approval process, including state approval. Som
