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Summary of Activities this Year:

The Rowan Core Committee had a busy year. In a series of policy meetings, we developed and approved a revised Rowan Core policy proposal—based on changes that were made during the Deplacemental proposal but that they need clearer guidelines and a manageable assessment plan. We have already developed the new LIT guidelines, and we will continue working on both requirements next year. Sub-groups of approximately 4 or 5 committee members met to review proposals to add new courses to Rowan Core. Some proposals are still under review, but we expect to have 29 courses added to Rowan Core by Fall 2019. The committee chair has done additional work managing and continuing the implementation of the Rowan Core general education program.
