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*The teaching of writing should be a central focus of the course. Writing assignments must comprise a significant portion of the course grade.*

*To allow for this focus on writing instruction, the maximum number of students for WI courses be strictly enforced. (Some specific courses may have more than 22 students. (Some specific courses may have more than 22 students.)*

*As much as is possible, instructors should tailor assignments and practices for the course subject. (E.g., a course on environmental reports, or a WI political science course might use a similar format.)*

*Instructors should also follow general best practices for writing instruction. Course time should be dedicated to writing instruction (e.g., on the syllabus).*

*Instructors should employ scaffolded writing assignments, work-shops, outlining and annotated review, etc.)*
